## **SCHOLARSHIP RULES**

- 1.) Applicants must be graduating from U.S.A. or accelerated school for the said academic school year within the Area 5.
- 2.) Be a biological child, stepchild, or grandchild of a transportation employee.
- 3.) A transportation employee includes:
  - a. School Bus Driver
  - b. School Bus Monitor / Attendant
  - c. Mechanic, Assistant Mechanic
  - d. Transportation Fleet Manager
  - e. Transportation Supervisor
  - f. Transportation Trainer
  - g. Secretary
  - h. Transportation Director / Manager

- 4.) Applicate must have attended and graduated from a US School and resided in Area 5 to qualify for the STAPT Scholarship.
- 5.) Information on applications must be complete and legible (handprinted or typed).
- Applicants must submit application, transcripts, and recommendations via e-mail to <u>Pete.stapt@gmail.com</u> by <u>Friday</u> <u>May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023 11:59 pm</u>. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- 7.) The S.T.A.P.T. current serving officers will review scholarship recipients' applications to make determinations on submitted applicants' information and available funds slated for scholarships. Determinations will be announced by Wednesday May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023, on the S.T.A.P.T. website (stapt.net).
